



Atomoxetine



Increases noradrenaline activity and helps with impulsive behaviour, focus, concentration and hyperactivity (signs of ADHD)

A bit better after 1 -2 weeks, full effects at 8 weeks.

Common side-effects are loss of appetite, trouble sleeping, stomach ache, feeling dizzy, headache, feeling tired, constipation, racing or fluttering heart

Physical health tests to check your heart, weight and height

Talk to your doctor if you want to stop it

Take it in the morning with breakfast and see your doctor every 3-6 months

Call your doctor if you get more angry or agitated or have thoughts of hurting yourself
